



2019 Kids Day Parade Terms & Conditions

Date: Saturday, May 11th, 2019

Parade Hours: 9:30 am to 10:15 pm

Location of parade: The parade will be on College Street! The parade begins at corner of College Street and Church Street. Parade route is the length of College Street, ending at Waterfront Park. Staging is on the lower blocks of Church Street, as well as one block of College Street.

Parade Details:

The Kids Day Parade is a fun celebration of kids that kicks off the Kids Day event! The parade is \$50 per organization this year, for administrative and security/safety costs. Participants will gather on Church Street for the start of the parade, with vehicle staging on College Street between S. Winooski and Church streets. That section of College Street will be closed down to thru-traffic at 8:30 am. Parade leaders will be on hand to assist in bright yellow vests. Participants will be emailed assignments for lining up at the end of April. The parade begins at 9:30 am and runs until approximately 10:15 am.

Floats:

Floats may not be taller than 15 feet, wider than 8 ½ feet, and longer than 50 feet. Nothing should be hanging from the float or near the tires. If people are on the float, there must be guardrails around the entire space. They must be 34 inches high from the bottom of the float bed. They must be sturdier than rope.

Break-down:

The parade ends at the bottom of College Street, at the intersection of Main Street. Parking spaces will be blocked off along that stretch. All floats with people riding in them must pull over there and unload all riders. Floats *cannot* continue down Lake Street, they must turn left up Main Street and exit Waterfront Park. All parade participants on foot will continue onto the bikepath and into the festival site.

Advertising:

This event is advertised widely through various television, print and radio sponsors, as well as through the BPRW program guide, various online calendars and social media. Vendors are encouraged to list Kids Day on their website and social media, and share with their local customer base.

Cancellation Policy:

Kids Day is held rain or shine, but if severe weather or other conditions appear, BPRW officials operating together with Police and Fire officials reserve the right to cancel all activities. No refunds will be issued in this instance. There is no rain date for Kids Day.

Participant Responsibilities:

The participant including, but not limited to its employees, agents and/or volunteers will be responsible for its operations and for all materials, tools, equipment, appliances, and property. The participant assumes all risks of direct and indirect damages or injury to person or property wherever located, resulting from any action, omission, commission or operation at Kids Day. Participants are responsible for keeping their group organized and behaving properly, as well as following all directions given by parade staff and police officers.
